Immobel acquired the vehicles holding title to the site in 2020 and completed the redevelopment in early 2022. Since the acquisition and following the full refurbishment of the site, the occupancy rate increased from 40% to about 86%.

The Woods enjoys quick and easy mobile access, and features adapted parking spaces. It is located adjacent to the Groenendael train station, which is only three stops from the Brussels European district and ideal for local company hubs.
